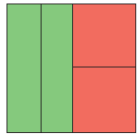
Maths

This week we will be starting to look at fractions using Oak Academy. Start on [lesson 6](#) complete a new lesson every day.

Challenge: Can you solve these 2 problems?

The shape is divided into 4 equal parts. Do you agree?

Explain why.



Six girls share three bars of chocolate equally.
Four boys share two bars of chocolate equally.

Does each girl get more chocolate, less chocolate or the same amount of chocolate as each boy?

Draw a picture to show that your reasoning is correct.

Fluency:

Carry on working on quick recall of the 3 and 6 times table facts. Use the rolling number songs to help you.

English

Oak Academy: This week we are working on narrative writing based on The Happy Prince. Start on [lesson 11](#) then complete a new lesson every day. If you missed lesson 1, start the lesson 1 video at 12 minutes in, so you can listen to the story of The Happy Prince to get you started.

Writing challenge: We have been learning about traditional tales, so have a go at taking a story setting from one story and a character from a different story and write what happens. You could write about Red Riding Hood visiting a castle or The Three Little Pigs climbing up a beanstalk. Remember to write in sentences and you could include some inverted commas when your characters are speaking to each other. Please send your work in using 2Email.
