What do you know about the Anglo-Saxons? Who were they? Where did they come from? Why did they invade Britain? Watch this [clip](#).



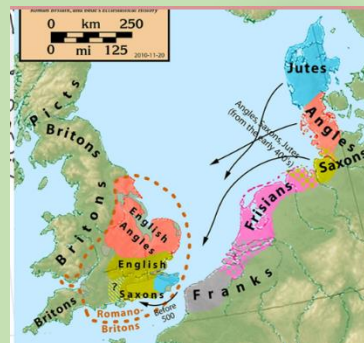
Look at map of the routes the Anglo-Saxon groups took to settle in England:
