

This is an overview of the main areas of learning in Year 3 for this week which will link to the learning going on in school.

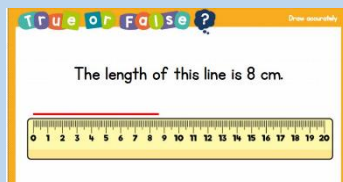
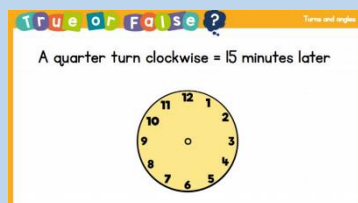

Oak Academy: This week we are starting a unit on non-chronological reports about Portia spiders. Start on [lesson 1](#) and then complete a new lesson every day.

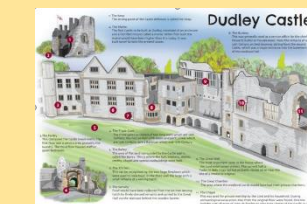
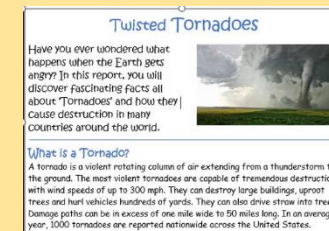
Writing challenge: This is an examples of a non-chronological report. Look and see what features you can spot.
