






Shapes of the week: Triangular prism
 A triangular prism is a 3D shape. How many faces does it have? Would it be a good shape to build a tower with?



Activity: Write the numbers 11- 20 on pieces of paper. Encourage your child to count out objects to match the numbers. They could even draw spots or make marks with crayons. Encourage your child to start with 10 objects and then add more to reach the number.

Reading: *Read these sentences. Can you spot the digraphs? (Remember 2 letters, 1 sound)*

Writing:
 Here are some words-**river, finger, tooth, looking, waiting, singing, zooming, carpark**
 Encourage your child to write these words by using their segmenting fingers to identify how many sounds are in the word. This will then help them to write the sounds they need to build the word.
