This term- During the Spring term we have enjoyed looking at the history of Ancient Egypt. We completed various engaging and informative activities, to gain an understanding of what life was like at the time. All of the children loved learning about the importance of mummification and then having the opportunity to create their own mummified tomato. To celebrate World Book day we shared the book Grandpa Chatterj and created and designed our own festival elephants, the children worked hard designing and using traditional Indian patterns. In Science we studied the human digestive system, the children experienced first-hand how our digestive system works through a practical experiment using tights, Weetabix and orange juice. We looked at the effect that food and drink has on our teeth and how we can protect our teeth from decay using eggs and a variety of different fluids. The children all worked well making predictions and monitoring and recording any scientific changes, the result included a bouncy, shell-less egg and changes in colour.

Next term we are looking forward to learning about Mountains and Rivers in IL and states of matter in Science. We look forward to telling you about our exciting new projects in the Summer term.


