



Year 1 – Week 7 – Weekly Activities

Topic (Health and Wellbeing/PSHE)

What can you remember about the seaside? Have you ever been to the beach? Would you like to go to a beach? Although the beach is a fun place, you must stay safe. What do you think it means to stay safe at the beach and can you come up with some rules you think people should follow in order to stay safe?



Can you create a poster about staying safe at the beach? Remember to include key rules and safety advice on your poster.

Science (Experiment)



Did you know the sea has salt in? This week we would like you to carry out a science experiment with a bit of help from a grown up.

What do you think will happen if you put salt into water? Have a think and write a prediction. Next, put a teaspoon of salt on a small plate, add just enough water to cover the salt (you don't need much), what happens? Then leave your plate by the window for a couple of days. When you come back to it what have you noticed?

Maths Fluency

This week we are focusing on the 2 times table. Can you say it forwards and backwards? What items can you find in your house that comes in pairs? Can you count them?

What numbers come in both the 2 and 5 times table?
