







Year Group: Nursery	WEEK BEGINNING: 14/3/2022

**Number, shape & measures:**  
**Counting:** Sing along with this counting song [Five little ducks went swimming one day - BBC Teach](#)  
 Use plastic ducks, if you have them, or otherwise draw 5 ducks and number them 1-5. How many can they see? Can they put them in the correct order?



**Irresistible Learning Topic: Down at the Farm**  
**Understanding of the World: Life Cycles**  
**Activity 1:** Do you know what a baby chicken is called? Do you know what a baby chick starts as? Watch this video to find out the life cycle of a chicken. [The life cycle of a chicken](#)  
**Activity 2:** Look at the pictures below of a baby chick and a duckling. Can you use some good describing words for them? Can you make a picture of a chick? Use whatever materials you want or have available.






**Communication, language & literacy**  
**Reading:** This week we are reading the book **Hatch, Egg, Hatch!** Watch [Hatch, Egg Hatch!](#) What ways did the Mother Hen try to get the egg to hatch?  
**Phonics Rhyme-** Listen to this story [Hen's Pens](#) which words rhymed with 'hen' in the story?  
**Writing/Mark Making:** Get your adult to draw you an egg shape. See if you can draw zig zags on it like the hen in the story.
