

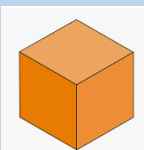

Number, shape & measures:

Number of the week: Our [number of the week](#) this week is 4. Can you count out 4 objects? Can you draw 4 dots? What is one more and one less than 4?



Shape of the week: cube. A cube is a 3D shape. It has 6 square faces and 8 vertices. Can you find any cubes at home?

Activity: In school we are thinking about time language. Each day discuss what you did yesterday and what you will do tomorrow. Discuss your daily routines and think about what you do in the morning, in the afternoon and in the evening. On Wednesday it will be the first day of the month of December. How many sleeps will it be until Christmas day?
