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This is an overview of the main areas of learning in Year 3 for this week which will link to the learning going on in school. Please use these as the main activities for home-learning if your child is unable to attend school during this week.

<p>Maths Oak Academy – this week we’ll be starting a new unit on securing multiplication and division facts. Complete a lesson each day (lessons 1-5) by clicking here</p> <p>Challenge – Lesson 1 – commutativity between multiplication and division Lesson 2 – use known number facts to derive the 6x table Lesson 3 – use known number facts to derive the 8x table Lesson 4 – multiply 2-digit numbers by 6 Lesson 5 – multiply 2-digit numbers by 8.</p> <p>Mental fluency Log onto TT Rock Stars to improve your speed and recall of multiplication and division facts. Have a go at telling at the time at different times of the day, what time do you get up? How long until lunch? What time did you start playing your favourite game and how long did you spend playing it? The best way to learn the time is by spending just a few minutes every day learning to tell it in every day situations.</p>	<p>English Oak Academy – this week we complete our unit focusing on explanation texts. Click here and complete one lesson a day (11-15) of How Bees Make Honey.</p>  <p>Extra writing challenge: in school we will be reading Mufaro’s Beautiful Daughters. Watch the story here . Choose one of the characters and write a detailed description. Remember to include adjectives and similes.</p> <p>Reading: Log onto Bug Club to see what books your teacher has given you to read. Perhaps you could create a book review of the book you most enjoyed reading.</p> <p>Spelling: Log into Purple Mash and you will find your spelling list has been set as a 2do. There is also a spelling quiz for you to complete. This week’s spellings are words with the initial s sounds spelt ci, ce or cy.</p> 
<p>Irresistible Learning: Italian Adventure-Roman Food This week we are looking at the range of food that both rich and poor Romans ate. Look at the word bank to see some of the unusual foods that they ate. You can also use this link to learn about Roman foods. Complete the 2Do on Purple Mash to create your own Roman menu.</p>  <p>Science: Light and Dark This week we finish our unit on light. Complete the Oak Academy lesson entitled ‘how can you change the size of a shadow?’ by clicking here .</p> 	<p>Wellbeing-Caring for the Earth It is World Oceans Day on the 8th June.
