

Number, shape & measures:
Number of the week: 13. Watch this episode of [Numberblocks](#) to learn about 13. Can you make 13p with 10p and 1ps?



Shapes of the week: rectangle and a cuboid. Can you compare a rectangle and a cuboid?

Challenge:



Make a toy shop by labelling some of your favourite toys with prices. Play with your toy shop and count out the correct amount of pennies to pay for your toy. In school we have practised using a 10p and 1ps to make amounts between 11p and 19p. See if you can do this at home too.

Activity 1: Listen to the story [Michael Recycle](#)



What do you know about recycling? How do you recycle at home? Can you help your grown up to recycle some things at home. On Espresso search **Going Green** and explore the module by watching the videos and looking at the pictures.

Activity 2: Using some recycled materials at home have a go at making a musical instrument and explore the sounds that you can make.

Listen to the story of 'Noah's Ark' from the Bible on [Espresso](#) Search Noah's Ark and then click on Foundation. Share the story together.



Noah's experience is similar to our own experiences of isolation in lockdown/quarantine. Think about some of the things you enjoyed doing at home and maybe things you didn't like as much. Noah could have given up on waiting for all of the floods to be over, but he persevered and with God's strength was able to push through into a new way of life
