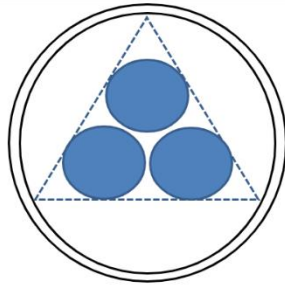


Topic: Made in the Midlands (Art - History - Geography)

Stick to 3 or 4 roses only

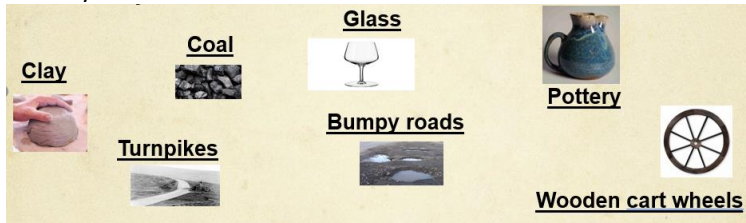
Use red, green, blue, yellow, blue, white, pink, black
