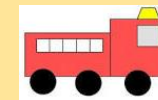




Year Group: Nursery	WEEK BEGINNING: 25/1/2021

<p><b>Number, shape &amp; measures:</b>  <b>Number of the Week: 4</b> <a href="#">Watch: Numberblocks: 4</a>                  Can you show your adult 4 fingers? Can you find 4 of different objects in your house? You could find 4 pencils, 4 toys, 4 cushions, 4 books etc. See if you can write the number 4.  <b>Make 4</b>                  Using the items you have found around your house, 4 pencils, and 4 toys. How many different ways can you make 4?                  Take some photos and send them to us on Evidence Me.  <b>Shape of the Week: hexagon</b>                  How many sides does a hexagon have? Can you count them?                  Click here <a href="#">Espresso</a> then <b>Foundation-Shape-Videos-Flat shapes around us.</b></p>	<p><b>Communication, language &amp; literacy</b>  <b>Word of the Week: orange</b>  <u>Reading:</u> we are sharing the story of <b>Fireman Fergus</b> this week. Listen to the story together <a href="#">Fireman Fergus</a> What was blocking the road? What did Fergus rescue out of the tree?  <b>Phonics: Session 1 Body Percussion</b> - See if you can sit with your family and get your adult to make a sound with their body first (click fingers, clap hands etc). See if you can copy them. Can you then perform two body sounds together, then maybe try three. See if you can take it in turns to make the sounds then see if other family members can copy them.  <b>Session 2</b> This week we are learning the sound ‘p’ Listen to this song <a href="#">Jolly Phonics Song p</a> See if you can do the action and say the sound. Can you think of anything that begins with ‘p’? [pig, pink, pin, pot] Have a look for some objects around your house that begin with ‘p’ You can also watch this video on Scrap phonics letter p <a href="#">Espresso</a> then <b>Foundation-Literacy-Phonics-Scrap Phonics.</b>  <u>Writing/Mark Making:</u> See if you can draw a picture of a <b>fire engine.</b></p>
<p><b>Irresistible Learning Topic: <a href="#">Make a Rainbow: Colours Colour- orange</a></b>  <b>Activity 1:</b> Make a fire picture. You could draw or paint your fire picture. How about ripping up some red and orange paper to make the flames?  <b>Activity 2:</b> Talk about people who help us. Who has helped to keep us safe this year? Draw a picture of someone who helps us.  <b>Activity 3:</b> Talk about firefighters. What do they do? How do they keep us safe? Log onto <a href="#">Espresso</a> then <b>Foundation-Understanding of the World-People Who Help Us-Firefighters.</b>  <b>Activity 4:</b>                  Can you make a fire engine out of Lego/Duplo/boxes? Pretend you or your teddy/doll is a firefighter. Tell a story. What happens in your story?</p>	<p><b>Wellbeing: The Big Garden Birdwatch</b> takes place from <b>29<sup>th</sup>-31<sup>st</sup> January.</b>  <a href="#">Click</a> to have a look at the RSPB website where you can sign up. It is simple to take part you just have to spend an hour counting the birds that you see in your garden or from your window. You could take part as a family and join in with the world’s largest wildlife survey. There are lots of resources on the website to help you identify different birds along with things to make and activities that you could do as a family. Most of all have fun taking notice of the world around us.</p>
