This is an overview of the main areas of learning in Year Reception for this week which will link to the learning going on in school. Please send pictures of your child's work to their teacher via Evidence Me.


Number, shape & measures:

Number of the week: 7. Watch this [Numberblocks](#) episode about the number 7.

Shape of the week: heptagon. A heptagon is a 2D shape with 7 sides and 7 corners. Can you find a coin that is shaped like a heptagon?

Challenge:

Collect 9 small objects and try arranging them in different ways. Look at the shells below to give you some ideas. In the first arrangement you might notice a group of 5 and a group of 4 to make 9. In the second group you might see three rows of three. How can you make 9? You could try this activity with 10 small objects too.



The World/topic Irresistible Learning Topic: Spring/Creativity

Activity 1: What do you know about Spring? On Espresso search 'Spring'. Read the foundation module book.

Listen to the [Numberblocks Spring song](#). Can you count how many objects you can see with the Numberblocks?



Activity 2: Can you see some daffodils? You might see some in your house or out of the window. What colours are they? Can you draw the daffodils? You might even paint them.

On Espresso search 'Daffodils and Primroses' and click on the foundation image. This will help you see what daffodils look like.


Reading: Read some of your books on [Bug Club](#).
