September 2023 information:

We look to seeing everyone looking smart coming back to school in September 2023.

School uniform - we ask that uniform is labelled as the children start new classes.

Grey trousers, shorts, skirts, pinafores etc. Green sweatshirts or cardigans. White shirts or polo tops. **PE kit –** we ask that children come to school on PE days wearing: trainers, plain black shorts or joggers and the coloured house T shirts. PE days are not mufti days. Earrings and jewellery should not be worn on PE days.

Book bags – we ask that children bring book bags to school for Reading books, we don't have the storage space for 30 large bags for each class in school, all the resources children need are in class. There is room in lockers for a winter coat and a small bag for Year 6.



Broadway end of day dismissal - Reception,
Year One or Year Two – as new staff get used to
identifying new parents to safely dismiss at the end of the
day routines, please be patient. New Reception will be
closest to the school hall, and Year 2 closest to the
Nursery outdoor classroom. We ask that parents wait
behind the class marker so that the younger children can
be dismissed to parents at the front of the queue first.
If you are waiting for older siblings, collect the youngest
first, then please move to the back of the playground
ensuring the way in and out are kept clear (marked in red
on map). Thank-you.



Heath Farm Road end of day dismissal – as new staff get used to identifying new parents to safely dismiss at the end of the day routines, please be patient. Year 3 are new to Heath Farm Road and will line up in the same way as the younger children, and be dismissed to parents at the front of the queue. Thank-you.

Please note that due to Safeguarding procedures we are not able to release children from Reception, Year One or Year Two via Heath Farm Road.

Sibling drop off at Broadway will remain unchanged, end of day collection for children in existing Reception and Year 1 will remain unchanged (otherwise two collection points).

We would ask you to complete a Microsoft request form, which will be sent out next week, if arrangements have changed due to a new September 2023 Reception starter.
