The intention is that pupils will be encouraged to continue studying languages beyond KS2 and ultimately be working towards becoming life-long language learners. Gig Mill intends to use the Language Angels programme and resources to ensure we offer a relevant, broad and vibrant foreign languages curriculum that will inspire and excite our pupils using a wide variety of topics and themes.

At The Café Pupils will learn: to say and write what they are ordering to eat and/or drink using a wider range of vocabulary alongside very useful transactional language.

My Family Pupils will learn: the knowledge and skills to make a presentation about their own/a fictitious family in both spoken and written form.  The Date Pupils will learn: the days of the week, months of the year and numbers 1-31 in order to say the date and when their birthday is.	Do you have a pet? Pupils will learn: to say the pets they have and/or do not have, using 3 <sup>rd</sup> person to say what a pet is called and use conjunctions more confidently.  My Home Pupils will learn: the knowledge and skills to present orally and in written form about where they live and which rooms they have/do not have in their home.
