## Sport Relief Total

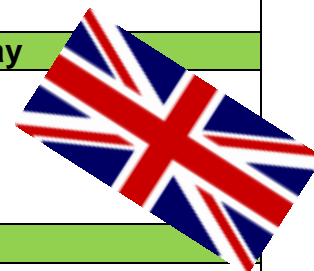
